- Develop a Lake-Wide Program for the Early Detection of Aquatic Invasive Species
 - Seek assistance from local lake associations who have early detection programs.
 - Testing for new Invasive's - Spiny Water Flea, Clams, et al.
- Shoreline resident program to identify hot spots - **Luke Aalmans**
- Provide reconnaissance and management assistance to milfoil harvesting contractors, with Warren County Soil and Water management (SWCD) programs.
- Coordinate the Mat moving program-**Terry Lynch**
- Advocate for a Boat Wash Station for Brant Lake - **Doug Schultz**
- Coordinate Boat Launch Steward Program - **Gary Frenz - Jayne Wynne**

Lake & Clean Water Initiatives Chairman Wayne Butler

- Support the Development of a Lake Management Plan by SUNY Oneonta
 - Implement a two (2) part program over three (3) years designed to give increased understanding of Brant Lake and provide a basis for the implementation on a Lake Management Program
- Work with the NYS Federation of Lake Associations (NYSFOLA) for sampling, handling, and analysis of Brant Lake water quality data.
